I'm a part of this 'Nation of the Cross' and it doesn't have a nation, it is an international, world-wide community of people who believe that this is actually not the worst thing you can do to us. Terrorism and acts that are designed as symbolic fear-driven aggressive acts of bullying only strengthen our resolve to lay down our lives. You can't kill people who have already died. That's who you are talking about and who you are talking to when you address "the people of the Cross."

The people of God have faced worse things than this before and we actually have a bit of historical perspective on what God does with our spilled blood. "The blood of Christians is the seed of Christianity" one early Jesus follower wrote during a much scarier time than this. May we join the voices of the saints in Heaven looking on asking, "How long O Lord?" May the families of these brothers and sisters receive the comfort of God and may these martyrs rest in peace and rise in glory.
